3. Skype conference with Andriana

Discussion of the communication and dissemination strategy followed by email with discussion summary and tasks assigned to each partner (attached).

4. Face-to-face training package

While discussing the O2 (face-to-face-training package), we agreed that our training programs should consist of some common elements in order to show consistency and added value of working together on the European level.

We agreed the common objectives of our training programs should be:

- to provide the participants with knowledge of their rights
- to give simple and basic, but relevant information
- to empower and build the participants' confidence in public institutions
- to direct the participants towards institutions that may provide them with the right support
- to give the participants skills and knowledge with regards to what they can do if they face discrimination

We also agreed that our training programs should have a common structure and not take more than 2-4 hours. In order to maintain the same training structure, SIP will develop a "shell" (a template) easy to fill in with various content by each of the partners. SIP as the task leader will propose the outline of such shell, send it to all the partners and wait for their feedback.

Training related ideas:

- Gamification: game simulations for the youth; games regarding discrimination that include some basic legal information. This can be a good format to use at schools and while working with younger participants.
- Showing the participants some positive examples of people who reported discrimination and succeeded (real cases).
- When training professionals, it is worthwhile to spend some time working on their empathy and sensitizing them to the needs of the discriminated youth.

When designing training programs, we should remember:

- To involve the youth in the training



- As the project relates to public legal education, the objective of the training is to provide basic, albeit legally correct information. We should pay particular attention to the language - explaining legal terms in an easy way, and making sure that the training content is understandable to the participants
- To incorporate research results in the training
- To provide the training to young migrants/ refugees in relevant languages (e.g. Arabic, French) when applicable
- We could arrange for young people to meet professionals who work in the field
- Young trainee lawyers could be involved in the delivery of training

5. Risk register

No comments relating to this matter. Risk register was accepted by all partners.

6. Conference on Cyprus

We agreed to combine the transnational project meeting and the international conference in order to give all partners an opportunity to participate in the event. All partners will present their research findings during the conference. We also discussed bringing an academic institution (i.e. a local university) on board as a co-organizer in order to raise the profile of the event and encourage international academic participation (in order to reach the number of international participants described in the project proposal). We have not set a final date for the event and the transnational project meeting.

KISA as the event organizer will prepare a draft program/ event description for Andriana to disseminate.

AnM budget cannot cover full costs of flights and accommodation for the conference participants. Budget for a local participant is 100 euro.
